Psalm 113:3 From the rising of the sun to the place where it sets, the name of the Lord is to be praised.

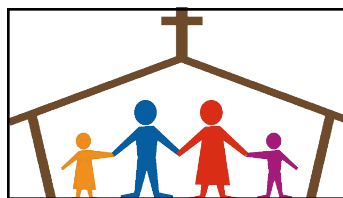
Praise God for the break in humidity (for now!). Praise God for the sun. Praise God for the rain. And Praise God for the moon. But most importantly, Praise God for you!!
