Invite a friend and plan to attend. Come early for fellowship. Let's fill the pews and share the love.

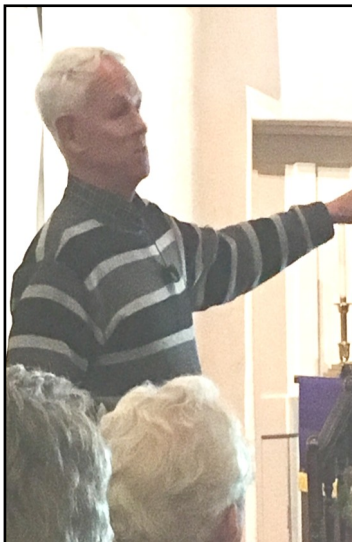
The topic for this final session will be "The End Times."
