Today, Indiana United Methodist Children's Home is an open campus facility with group homes designed to offer services to youth who are in need of a less restrictive setting. Youth who benefit the most from the services offered by the Home include:

youth who are experiencing difficulties in the educational setting, both academic and/or behavioral.

youth who have a history of alcohol or drug abuse but are not in need of inpatient substance abuse treatment.

youth who have completed inpatient psychiatric or drug/abuse treatment and are in need of transitional placement prior to returning home or being placed in a less restrictive placement (i.e. foster home, independent living). Their multi-faceted treatment program aids youth who cannot cope with the everyday responsibilities of family living.


