Monthly Mission for June

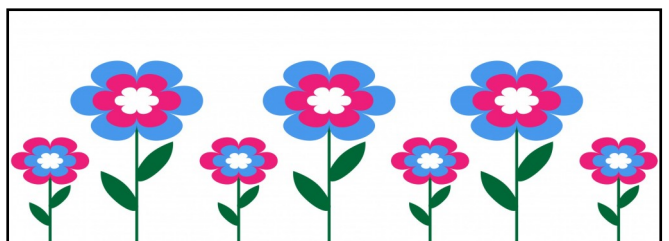
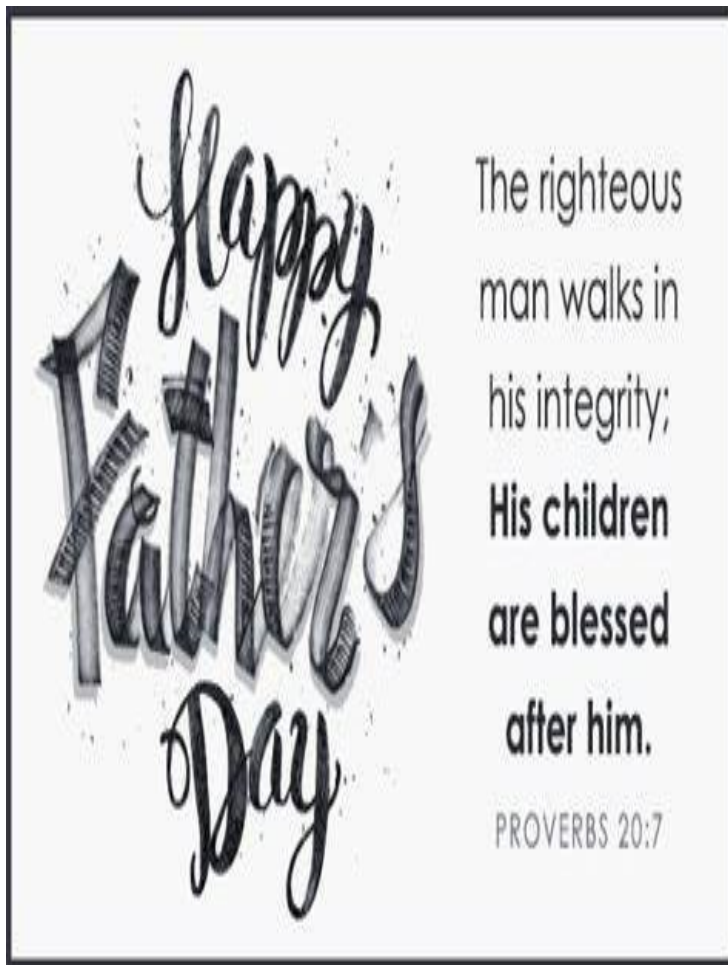
The monthly mission for June is Mobility Worldwide. Mobility Worldwide is a faith-based, volunteer-driven, 501(c)(3) Non-profit organization. PET is an acronym for the Personal Energy Transportation vehicle that the group constructs and distributes at no cost to provide the gift of mobility to disabled children and adults worldwide. PET International, Inc. began doing business as Mobility Worldwide in August 2016 and began using the name Mobility Cart for the vehicle. Since 1994, over 80,000 Mobility Carts have been built and distributed by over 70 distribution partners. Generous donors have pledged that they will match dollar-for-dollar, every Mobility Worldwide MO-Columbia donation received this spring.

We will open again for Church service only on Sunday, June 14. Here is a list of the guidelines we will follow:

1. Church service only—no Sunday School, Junior Church or Hospitality area. Children will remain with parents.
2. If you have ANY COVID-19 symptoms or exposure, please do not come.
3. Offering plates and donations to the monthly mission will be at entrances to sanctuary and will not be passed during service.
4. You will sanitize your hands at entrances (sanitizer will be provided).
5. Masks must be worn at all times while assembled together. (masks will be provided)
6. We will practice social distancing and remain a minimum of 6 feet apart (specific pews may be designated).
7. You will dispose of tissues and trash in the individual bags at end of the pews.
8. There will not be hymn singing. We will try to provide music through the audio/video system.
9. There will be no Passing of the Peace.
10. We will sanitize the pews between services.

If you are uncomfortable being in church, do not come. If you are symptomatic, do not come. We will continue to offer the sermon virtually. Our goal is to offer a safe, Christ filled worship experience. Please know that your leadership team is monitoring the recommendations from the Governor, the CDC, the Bishop and local data updates to make the best decision possible.
