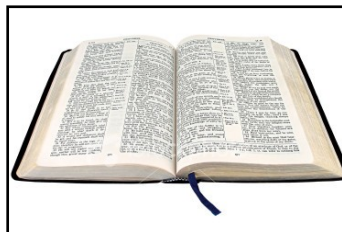
From the Pastor

2019 CHARGE-CONFERENCE

This year's Charge Conference was conducted in the East district on Sunday October 20th. Churches from the local area gathered in New Castle at the New Castle 1st United Methodist Church.

The session was called to order at 6 pm with prayer and a time of praise before the business session was conducted. During the session the three annual required Charge Conference reports from each district church were brought to the floor and adopted by vote of the delegates present.

New Conference Superintendent Russ Abel shared with the delegates a message of encouragement concerning the story each Christian disciple has that can be shared as a witness to others. He called it "Your Story" and

emphasized no one knows it better than YOU.

The charge conference focus going forward was definitely the Bishop's vision for each Church in the Indiana Conference becoming more Missional in their work making disciples for Christ. As an example of this Pastor Ted Chalk (Pastor of the Centerville UMC and Richmond FUMC) addressed the delegates on the work they are doing in their communities in food distribution efforts and a list of other activities demonstrating their compassionate heart for "The Least of These".

Afterwards an offering was taken to support a Muncie project providing housing for the needy.

The session was closed after Superintendent Abel gave the benediction.
